    - Cat. 2 (7,500hr/60mo within the last 8 years)

    - 35h of formal project management courses
    - For Cat 1., bachelor degree
  - Pass Examination
  - Agree to Abide by the Code of Professional Conduct


#### PMP® Certification Examination

- Examination
  - 200 questions, MCA
  - 4 hours
  - computer-based examination
  - at Prometric (worldwide and Montreal)
- The official language of the PMP Certification examination is English. However, candidates can choose from seven other languages to aid them while taking the exam. Language aids are offered in Brazilian Portuguese, Chinese, *French*, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, and Spanish.

#### PMI-Montreal

- PMP Examination Preparation Seminars
  - 3 waves: in Fall, Winter and Spring
  - 5 formats in each wave:
    - 5 consecutive days over 1 week FR
    - 5 consecutive days over 1 week ENG
    - 5 consecutive Saturdays FR
    - 8 consecutive Tuesday evenings+ 1 Saturday FR
    - 8 consecutive Wednesday evenings + 1 Saturday ENG
  - Total of 35hours to meet education requirements
  - Private sessions upon demand in French or English
  - English material only
  - 750\$CAD/members 900\$CAD/non-members
  - PMI-Montreal membership: 30\$US (become a member!!!)





## Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) Program

In order to maintain the PMP credential, individual PMPs must obtain 60 PDUs during a three-year cycle to satisfy all elements of the Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) Program. There are five categories:

- Post certification formal education
- Self-directed learning and professional activities
- Programs sponsored by PMI Registered Education Providers (R.E.P.s)
- Programs sponsored by other providers
- Service to professional/community associations
